









Reconnect. Rediscover. Renew.

Locally led learning

Our project aims to encourage individuals and groups back into learning, training or employment through motivating and relevant theme-based courses which bring back a sense of belonging and reconnection to the local area.

WE OFFER:

-  Sessions that motivate, encourage and support participants to move into sustainable ways of working, living and being.
-  A flexible approach to delivery that starts where the individual is and is entirely led by the interests, needs and requirements of that individual.
-  Outreach tutors who can deliver learning opportunities to remote areas within West Cornwall as well as 1-2-1 coaching and enhancement mentoring for more targeted support.
-  Engaging topics which connect the participant to the local area, history and community re-igniting a sense of place and purpose.
-  A wide range of activities which develop old skills and introduce new ones, plus opportunities to gain a qualification.
-  Embedded key (maths, English and ICT) and employability skills.
-  Tailored support with transition to mainstream education, training or employment.
-  Building confidence, pride and self-esteem and enabling participants to take back control of their lives.



To be eligible participants must be 19+, unemployed or inactive and living within specific areas of need in **Penwith, Porthleven and Helston**.
