The council will reduce its total pay bill by some £18m, these proposals will see a total reduction in jobs of 410 by 31st of March 2022. While 200 of these jobs will be removed by not filling vacant or time limited roles, it is proposed that 210 staff (FTEs) will exit through voluntary or compulsory redundancy. It is important to note that despite the unprecedented financial situation which require difficult decisions to be taken, a greater proportion of the Council's £1.2bn gross revenue budget will be directed to delivering essential frontline services for residents. An investment of £45m in adult social care is an example. The majority of the savings will come from making efficiencies and finding more effective ways of delivering the services our residents rely on.
